



NCC Pediatrics Continuity Clinic Curriculum: Continuity Patient Case Day

Pre-Meeting Preparation:

- Select 1-2 interesting cases and/or continuity patients to present.

Conference Agenda:

- Option 1: Review resident-prepared cases.
- Option 2: Conduct “**Chart-Stimulated Recall**”.
 - Open AHLTA. Select resident (s) and search for encounters over last month.
 - Scan chief complaints. Preceptor or fellow residents can select encounter.
 - Open note and review encounter, using following questions as *guide*.

Chart-Stimulated Recall Questions: *Adapted from [CSR Worksheet](#) (Schipper,2009)*

1. General Case Review

a. Clinical assessment

- i. Can you give me an overview of the case?
- ii. What features of the patient’s presentation led you to your top3 diagnoses?
- iii. If there was uncertainty about the case, how did you deal with it?
- iv. Is there anything else you wish you would have asked?

b. Investigations and Referrals

- i. Why did you choose the investigations that you did?
- ii. Were there other tests that you thought of but decided against? Why?
- iii. How did you decide whether to refer to a consultant?

c. Treatment and Management

- i. What features led you to choose the treatment that you did?
- ii. What were the patient’s expectations for treatment?
- iii. Do you feel you reached common ground with the patient?

d. Follow-up

- i. What did you decide was appropriate for follow up?
- ii. What factors influenced your decision?

2. Comprehensive Care

- a. Did you discuss preventive interventions? (*Think: Health Maintenance Modules*)
- b. On reflection, do you think there are some interventions that should be discussed?

3. Patient Factors

- a. Was there anything special about this patient that influenced your decisions regarding management? (e.g. compliance, past medical history, support systems)
- b. On reflection, is there anything about this patient you wish you knew more about?
