



# National Capital Consortium Pediatric Residency Program Electives

All residents will complete educational requirements set by the ACGME Pediatrics Residency Review Committee. As of July 2016, this includes 7 required 'additional subspecialty experiences' which are referred to in this program as 'Elective.'

The choice of electives is determined by the resident and the availability of the elective.

All residents must successfully complete **at least 4 of the 7 elective experiences** in the specialties defined as "Key Subspecialties." The list of Key and Non-Key Electives are listed below. All specialties are pediatric unless specifically stated otherwise.
