



Call Responsibilities



PL-1 WARD DAY SHIFT

Call Responsibilities

- Primary responsibility is all ward patients
- First call to ER for pediatric consults
- Discusses patient care issues with ward PL-2
- Carries WRNMMC PL-1 pager
- Responsible for all admissions and H&Ps as well as daily progress notes for admitted patients (including review and signature on medical student notes)
- Responsible for watch notes on all “watcher” & “unstable” patients with significant changes or interventions during the day
- Defers consults from outside ER/Clinic to senior resident on duty
- Responsible for maintaining and updating iPASS sign-out note

Duty Hours

- Attend ward handoff at 0600 and 1700 every day of the week. Typically covers Sunday AM shift.

PL-1 WARD NIGHT SHIFT

Call Responsibilities

- Primary responsibility for all ward patients
- First call to ER for pediatric consults
- Defers consults from outside ER/Clinic to senior resident on duty
- Discusses patient care issues with ward PL-2
- Carries WRNMMC PL-1 pager
- Responsible for all admissions and H&Ps for all admitted patients (including review and signature on medical student notes)
- Responsible for watch notes on all “watcher” & “unstable” patients
- Responsible for maintaining and updating iPASS sign-out note
- Engage senior resident in night float curriculum during downtime
- Review continuity clinic modules during downtime

Duty Hours

- Attend ward handoff at 1700 and 0600 Mon-Fri. Saturday and Sunday are the typical nights off each week.

PL-2/PL-3 WARD

Call Responsibilities

- Supervision of PL-1 in clinical decision making for ward and ER patients

Updated May 2020

- Assists PL-1 in writing admit notes on pediatric admissions to the ward throughout the academic year.
- Cosigns all PL-1 notes (including review and signature on directly supervised medical student notes).
- Responsible for watch notes on all “watcher” & “unstable” patients
- Evaluation of ER patients with the PL-1
- Receives outside phone calls from physicians, arranges transport to WRNMMC Ward. Responsible for arranging admissions to Ward
- Communication with attending staff and consultant regarding ward/ER patients
- Performs pediatric consults as requested by surgical services and per SOP on inpatients and discusses with attending pediatric staff
- Reviews charts of all pediatric surgical patients admitted to the pediatric ward including medication (mg/kg dosing) and fluid orders
- Communicates with charge nurse regarding pediatric bed status
- Carries code pager and Ward phone
- If receives a call from the nurse advice line requesting a consult with a parent, will provide consultation if clinical demands allow and will write AHLTA telephone consults accordingly. Send AHLTA notes to attending on service for co-signature
- Responsible for ensuring iPASS sign-out is up to date

Duty Hours

- Attends ward handoff at 0600 and 1700 Mon- Fri. Typically PL-2s cover $\frac{3}{4}$ of Saturday 24hr shifts and PL-3 covers $\frac{1}{4}$ of Saturday 24hr shifts.

PL-2/PL-3 PICU Call

Call Responsibilities

- Care of PICU patients
- Writes progress notes for PICU patients (including review and signature on medical student notes)
- Responsible for watch notes on all “watcher” & “unstable” patients
- Writes notes for "Charmed" patients on the ward.
- Discuss ward admissions/clinical management with PL-2 as needed
- Receives outside phone calls from physicians, assists with arranging transport to WRNMMC and arranges pediatric admissions to PICU
- Communication with attending PICU staff and consultants
- Provides supervision, advice, and assistance to ward PL-1 and PL-2 as needed
- Carries code and Rapid Response Team (RRT) pager and PICU phone
- Responsible for maintaining and updating sign-out sheet

Duty Hours

- Attends PICU handoff at 0600 and 1700.
- The PL3 on their PICU rotation, typically covers the 1st Saturday 24hr shift of their two-week block.

NICU PL-1 DAY SHIFT

Call Responsibilities

- Medical management of NICU patients
- Communication with senior resident and neonatal fellow regarding medical management of NICU patients
- Attends all deliveries requiring pediatric critical care services or any that the nursery service is unable to attend
- Carries Blue Bird vocera and code pager
- Writes H&Ps and progress notes for up to 10 NICU patients (including review and signature on medical student notes)
- Responsible for watch notes on all “watcher” & “unstable” patients

Duty Hours

- Attends handoff at 0600 and 1700. Typically covers Saturday AM shift.
- Rounds on weekends likely begins early around 0800

NEWBORN PL-1 NIGHT SHIFT

Call Responsibilities

- Medical management of MICC babies
- Communication with senior resident on NICU and/or NICU fellow for concerns regarding babies on the MICC service.
- Attends all deliveries requiring pediatric services
- Carries Blue Bird vocera as well as code pager
- Perform procedures on newborns admitted to the NICU or MICC.
- Writes H&P on infants being admitted to MICC (including review and signature on medical student notes)
- Self-direct learning with breastfeeding module, continuity clinic modules, prep questions, and lectures from senior resident on service

Duty Hours

- Shift week is five nights. It is typically Sunday-Thursday with Fri and Sat off.
- Attends handoff at 0600 and 1700.

NICU PL-2 DAY SHIFT:

Call Responsibilities

- Supervises NICU PL-1 in the acute medical management of NICU and MICC patients
- Reviews and cosigns all PL-1 notes (including review and signature on directly supervised medical student notes).
- Supervises the management of any emergent ER patients
- Attends all deliveries requiring pediatric services
- Carries Blue Bird vocera, NICU phone, and code pager

- Communicates with NICU fellow regarding management decisions for NICU and MICC patients
- Responsible for maintaining and updating sign-out NICU database

Duty Hours

- Attends handoff at 0600 and 1700. Typically covers Sunday AM shift.

NICU PL-3 NIGHT SHIFT:

Call Responsibilities

- Supervises NICU PL-1 in the acute medical management of NICU and MICC patients
- Responsible for writing H&Ps on any NICU admissions as well as writing watch notes on all “watcher” or “unstable” patients or patients on respiratory support requiring CPAP or higher
- Responsible for the management of any emergent ER patients
- Attends all deliveries requiring pediatric services
- Carries Blue Bird vocera, NICU phone, and code pager
- Communicates with NICU fellow regarding management decisions for NICU and MICC patients
- Responsible for maintaining and updating sign-out NICU database

Duty Hours

- Attends handoff at 0600 and 1700. Shift week is Monday through Friday night.
