



## Morning Report, Morning Conferences, & Grand Rounds



Attendance at educational conferences is required both by the Department of Pediatrics and by the RRC. Residents may be excused from morning report and conference if they are:

1. Addressing urgent patient-care issues
2. Rotating off-site
3. Complying with duty hours obligations
4. On leave or TAD/TDY
5. Approved for absence by the Program Director

Attendance is tracked for each trainee's permanent training record.

Morning report is at 0745 Monday-Friday. The location is usually in the America Building room 2525. It will be specified if it is in a different location on the academic calendar. A case will be presented from 0745-0810. A lecture will be given from 0810-0850. Some morning report conferences may be replaced by Housestaff meetings, Education/reverse education meetings, PI/QI meetings, Wellness. These will be designated on the academic calendar.

Grand Rounds is generally every other Wednesday morning from 0745-0845 at USUHS. Lecture title, date, and specific location will be emailed out to the Pediatric Listserv or on the academic calendar on the [www.nccpeds.com](http://www.nccpeds.com) website.

Simulation is generally every other Wednesday (opposite of Grand Rounds) from 0745-0850. It is generally located in the simulation center, Heroes Building, 4<sup>th</sup> floor. The location will be updated on the academic calendar if different.
