When it is necessary to conduct library research in order to accomplish patient care or medical research, residents will have access to the medical libraries at WRNMMC after normal working hours.

At WRNMMC, the library will let you sign up for a card key in order to enter the library after hours. Please see the library staff at the circulation desk during working hours and present your WRNMMC ID badge to accomplish this.
