The MMOC trip this year is for the Electronic Marksmanship Simulator Training, located at **Building 147**, **behind Lot Z**, about a 15-minute walk from clinic. The training allows for simulated firing of the M4 and M17 with possible scenarios including range qualification, advanced target practice, threat assessment, hostage situations, and more. Some of the training weapons can simulate recoil and reloading. Depending on the scenario and weapon availability, up to 4 firing lanes may be used at a time. Those who are not actively shooting will receive Army Warrior Task training. This is a fun way to practice shooting in various scenarios without the need for Kevlar, eye/ear protection, etc.
